The content of the presentations in this forum will include:

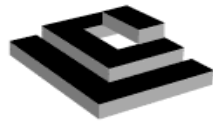
- Understand the role of design within the Lean Project Delivery System.

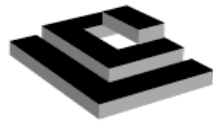
